THE 2011-2012 SCHOOL YEAR BEGINS AUGUST 9, 2011.

You want your child to be ready for the first day of school!

We want to be ready to serve your child on the first day of school!

It is more important than ever to pre-register your preschool child the week of February 28 - March 4, 2011 between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. at the school your child will attend. Older students may register March 7-11 between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. at the school they will attend. This may be the only opportunity to participate in registration and screening to ensure your child is able to start the first day of school.

WHO SHOULD PRE-REGISTER??

Students who will attend school for the first time next year should pre-register, including children who will attend kindergarten, the three and four year old preschool program and those transferring from another system.

HOW TO REGISTER FOR FOUR-YEAR OLD PROGRAM

To pre-register for the Monday through Thursday four-year-old program, a child must be four years old by October 1 and meet income eligibility guidelines or be a three or four year old child with diagnosed special needs. If you suspect that your three or four year old child has special needs, call Taysha Oglesby at the Warren County Schools Preschool Office, 781-1987 Ext. 107.

WHAT TO BRING TO REGISTRATION

Before a child may be officially enrolled, they must have a state issued birth certificate, Kentucky Immunization Certificate, a physical examination, and a vision examination. Also, please bring proof of address and income.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THOSE ENTERING SIXTH GRADE

Parents of children who will enter the sixth grade next year are reminded that state law requires that before enrollment, the student must have received the second MMR (measles, mumps and rubella) shot, a Hepatitis B Immunization, and they must have a physical examination.
